Correspondence

1. 27.08.2024 forwarded email regarding a status update on the report of fly-tipping on Wilsic Lane - due to the status of the land (private) enforcement lead on investigations and instruct/advise on clearance via the land, Street Scene will only clear fly-tip and waste from CDC land.
2. Report received of a rat infestation around Mill Dam. **RESOLVED** CDC Pest Control was contacted as part of the service contract and inspected on Monday 2/09/2024. 3rd bin emptied and been re-baited. 4th bin next to the sluice had no takes. Bins 1 & 2 no takes
3. Resident request for the bus stop to be re-instated to its original location at Spital Junction in time for school returning. **RESOLVED** CDC/Highways informed and the bus stop has now been reinstated.
4. 09/09/2024 Email complaint from a resident regarding Cherry Lane Garden Centre's appeal against the decision to use the small track to send HGV's down from Bawtry Road opposite Torne Valley's entrance. 23/01707/FUL
5. Email from Paula Thomas offering support via Tickhill Today distribution should TTC wish to consider applying to CDC to increase the number of Councillor seats.
6. Email request from external auditors for 2024/2025 budget calculations, minutes recording approval by the Council of the budget and 2024/25 precept request, and a breakdown of the Council's reserves, following 'information brought to the auditor's attention' from an anonymous source
7. regarding their concerns about the 2024/25 budget and precept setting processes. External auditors have a statutory responsibility to consider such information before completing limited assurance work on the 2023/24 AGAR. **RESOLVED** Temp RFO forwarded all information requested.
8. 12/09/2024 email from resident requesting further information on the appeal process for Cherry Lane Garden Centre 23/01707/FUL and requesting information following the Chair advising contact with CGC enforcement to investigate the drainage of the site. **RESOLVED** Chair introduced her to Andrew Towleron to help support her in her case in the appeal against planning
9. 12/09/2024 Email complaint from resident about a van dumping rubbish on the site on Wilsic Lane.
10. 12/09/2024 Resident emailed requesting information on two unauthorised transactions 'cardholder not present' on their credit card. **RESOLVED** Chris Taylor checked the bank account. No payments were received and Tickhill Town Council does not have the facility to take online payments. Responded suggesting the complainant investigate further with the bank as suspected cloning of card.
11. Resident complaint by telephone call to Chair re fly-tipping on Wilsic Lane.
12. Various quotes from energy supply companies looking for TTC to use them as new suppliers at the end of the current contract. **RESOLVED** contract not yet due for renewal, quotes to be considered.
13. Phone call from CDC to Chair advising value of 106 monies associated with the transfer of land of The Paddocks to TTC will be circa £16.5k. This will come via TTC solicitors and will need to be ring-fenced to use only in conjunction with that specific piece of land.
14. Email from CDC advising credit note for £3464.67 and refund will be issued for incorrectly charged invoice 30187582.
