- 1) B6376 Doncaster Road, Braithwell – from its junction with Micklebring Lane for 378m in a northerly direction
- 2) B6376 High Street, Braithwell - From its junction with Micklebring Lane to its junction with Ashton Lane
- 3) B6376 Maltby Lane, Braithwell - from its junction with Ashton Lane to its junction with Hoyle Croft Lane
- 4) B6376 Braithwell Road, Braithwell - from its junction with Hoyle Croft Lane to its junction with Birchwood Lane
- 5) B6376 Bridge Lane, Braithwell - from its junction with Birchwood Lane for 275m in a southerly direction

Time & Date

To commence on or after 6th April 2026 at 07:00 to 30th September 2026 at 19:00

Roads will be closed on up to 5 separate occasions, with each occasion lasting no longer than 3 consecutive days. Works MAY occur on a weekend

Additional Information

The start date will be notified via signs to be erected on site a minimum of 7 days in advance of the event commencing.

Those residents and businesses directly affected by the works are to be notified of the scheme to include access arrangements as well as during those times when duly notified of a legal requirement that will prevent driving and/or parking on certain lengths of the road. The letter will also indicate that any contravention of the conditions of the Order will result in a Penalty Charge Notice being issued and the subsequent removal of a vehicle.
