- All remarks shall be addressed to the Chair following the reports; please raise a hand if you wish to speak and the Chairman will decide the order of speaking if more than one person wishes to speak.
- Anyone entitled to and wishing to speak, shall do so for no longer than 2 minutes maximum unless the chairman decides otherwise
