1. Query from a potential resident looking to purchase a property in Tickhill. Wanting details of and flood plans **RESOLVED** discussed at the Doncaster Council Liaison meeting and CDC to investigate and advise information to pass on. CDC agreed to contact directly with information providing they are happy with this.
2. Report of flytipping on Peastack Lane. **RESOLVED** resident advised to report to CDC, emailed Ward Councillor to advise of report.
3. Resident complaint about the occupants of 54 Sunderland Street who have appropriated the “grass verge” outside the front of the property to continuously park their car, and in so doing have turned the superimposed area of their car into a muddy wasteland which will be difficult to revive without replanting the verge. Also, wild shrubs have been allowed to grow across the pavement restricting the pavement and scratching pedestrians as they pass by. **RESOLVED** emailed Ward Councillor to request appropriate action. Advised resident that Ward Councillor will follow up and advise action to be taken.
4. Email update from the Senior Flood Risk Engineer at CDC. Implementation of the Natural Flood Management Scheme (NFM) in Tickhill has been paused due to technicalities around long term funding arrangements detailed in the email circulated to all councillors. **RESOLVED** CDC to continue to monitor the implementation of the different funding opportunities, and by extension, determine whether it changes the viability of the scheme moving forward.
5. Email complaint from resident about the further deterioration and dumping of rubbish at the site on Wilsic Lane. **RESOLVED** reported again to the enforcement team at CDC and requested an update. Advised resident I will forward any information as soon as it is received from CDC.
6. Notification of price increase effective from 1st April 2025. **RESOLVED** circulated to councillors for information
7. Notification from SYMCA to advise decision by Olicer Coppard, Mayor of South Yorkshire to bring buses back under public control. **RESOLVED** circulated to councillors
8. Notice of Elections from CDC. **RESOLVED** circulated to all councillors, posted on Notice board and social media on 24.03.2025 as per statutory requirements.
