

MEETING OF TICKHILL TOWN COUNCIL 27th January 2027

220.25 CORRESPONDENCE (Appendix 3)

a) 17/12/2025 Email from a member of the public requesting information on the waiting list for the allotments. **RESOLVED** advised to contact City of Doncaster Council (CDC)

b) 19/12/2025 Email correspondence from a resident requesting information on the possibility of resident permits for Rawson Road. **RESOLVED** referred to the parking enforcement team at City of Doncaster Council

c) 21/12/2025 Telephone call from member of the public concerned about the number of incidents on the stretch of road between Tickhill and Malty, requesting FOI on the statistics and action by Rotherham or Doncaster Council. **RESOLVED** contacted South Yorkshire Police, CDC and Highways for information on how to proceed. As all accidents are not reported to the Police or relevant authority (Rotherham Borough Council in this case) there are insufficient statistics to evidence this stretch of road is statistically unsafe.

D) 05/01/2026 Letter from The Pensions Regulator requesting re-declaration of compliance. **RESOLVED** RFO submitted relevant paperwork and confirmation of declaration of compliance was received on 13/01/2026

e) 05/01/2026 email from Ramblers Association reporting a collapsed section of fencing on the corner of Wilsic Road and Wong Lane. **RESOLVED** reported to Ward Councillors and provided contact information for the Ward Councillors and CDC to enable them to report directly with further information of the exact location of the section of fencing and a photo for identification.

f) 06/01/2026 Acknowledgment letter from City of Doncaster Planning advising receipt of planning application 25/02495/TCON to remove Cypress to ground level and undertake light crown lift to the Dawn Redwood, Common Pear and Plum where feasible. **RESOLVED** circulated to members and to tree surgeon

g) 06/01/2026 Footpath letter from CDC planning drawing attention to the fact that should it be necessary to stop up, divert, or otherwise alter the right of way to enable development to proceed following the grant of permission of planning application 25/02495/TCON, TTC are required to apply to the CDC Highways for an order to be made under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended). **RESOLVED** Highways contacted for advice. As there is no public highway running through the car park there is no requirement to apply for a road/pathway closure, however part of the car park will require closing and advance notice to residents and members of the public. Barriers should be erected at the falling distance of the tree to protect members of the public.

h) 07/01/2026 report of bench outside cemetery being dangerous due to deterioration. **RESOLVED** reported to CDC via Ward Councillors as unable to verify responsibility within

CDC to pass to resident. CDC have since confirmed they have inspected the bench and an order to remove it has been placed. This will be carried out within their timeframe but is not a priority. A replacement bench will be ordered in the new financial year.

i) 08/01/2026 Roccas requesting information on how to apply for St Mary's car park closure for the Christmas late night opening event to facilitate children's fairground rides etc.

RESOLVED advised to discuss with Tickhill Together who organise the event who would need to submit a formal request to the Clerk.

j) 12/01/2026 Email received from a resident via Cllr private email to request Doncaster Council desist in spraying weed killer on the grass verges around the castle. **RESOLVED** replied to give details for resident to contact CDC directly or give permission for Tickhill Town Council to make contact on residents' behalf. CDC since confirmed the verge is scheduled for 13 cuts a year but due to parked cars it has been unsafe to carry out the cutting so the verges were sprayed instead. Agreed to desist spraying to allow grass verges to recover.

k) 12/01/2026 Email to request info on restriction on shop frontage and signage in the conservation area. **RESOLVED** details of the planning department forwarded for further advice.

l) Report of fly tipping of tyres in ditch on Wilsic Road. **RESOLVED** reported to Ward Councillors and the tyres have now been removed by CDC.

m) 13/01/2026 Email received from the Tickhill & District History Society to express concern over the purchase and possible demolition of the historic Toll House and wishing to register their strongest objection should such a proposal be advanced. **RESOLVED** responded to confirm no planning application had been received to date, however to look out for the planning application posted on the Tickhill Town Council website and public notice board and inviting members to the monthly council meetings where all planning matters are discussed.

n) 14/01/2026 Email from a member of the public reporting that the streetlight at the end of Dam Road, near the point where the road crosses the stream flowing to the Mill Dam, has been out of service since mid-November. **RESOLVED** reported to CDC and Ward Councillors. CDC updated; this column requires specialist access equipment due to its location. We are expecting the unit to be attended before the end of January. This type of works has a 28 day priority because we have to batch works with scaffolding to maximise operations. The column was reported on the 18th of December but highways has been closed over the festive. And then last week normal operations were suspended due to winter maintenance operations.

o) 14/01/2026 Demand for outstanding payment from British Gas for unpaid final bill from January 2022 (sully date 1-31st Dec 2021). **RESOLVED** Clerk and RFO fully investigated and made full payment of £177.18 on 16/01/2026.

p) 21/01/2026 Email from a company offering monthly service contracts for defibrillators. **RESOLVED** advised these are maintained and managed by a community group

- q) 21/01/2026 Email from historian and filmmaker wishing to discuss a proposal for filming for local heritage project. **RESOLVED** invited to January meeting.
- r) 22/01/2026 Email from resident asking for update on the trees in St Mary's Car park having read the minutes of the December meeting. **RESOLVED** advised going through the planning consultation process.
- s) 23/01/2026 Email from member of the public with feedback on the Christmas Eve Carols Event who felt the sound system was so poor they were unable to hear and lots of people were using it as a social gathering and chatting, with no interest in the singing making it even more difficult to hear the carols and the speakers. **RESOLVED** responded to thank the member of the public and we will take their comments on board when organising this years event.
- t) 24/01/2026 Complaint received via the website contact us of pothole on A60 Doncaster/Tickhill Road causing damage to vehicle. Member of public looking for compensation. **RESOLVED** forwarded relevant contact details at CDC and information for member of public to report directly to CDC.
- u) 26/01/2026 Minutes from Tickhill Together Meeting received. **RESOLVED** circulated to members for information.
- v) 27/01/2026 Email from member of the public wishing to be registered as a volunteer for the community orchard tree planting. **RESOLVED**. Emailed volunteer sign up and retention form and given details. Advised will contact with planting dates once we have confirmation from CDC.
