

MEETING OF TICKHILL TOWN COUNCIL 28th JULY 2026

88.26 CORRESPONDENCE (Appendix 3)

- a) **24/06/2026** Resident reported a hole in the footbridge 25 on the public footpath between Lindrick and Westgate. **RESOLVED** reported to Ward Councillors and a temporary fix has been made, with a permanent repair being scheduled.
- b) **25/06/2026** Email from resident reporting the poor state of the hedges on Common Lane, which are once again causing a safety concern for pedestrians. The resident last reported this on 12/05/2026, it was reported to City of Doncaster Council (CDC), however no maintenance has been carried out as a result and no response received. **RESOLVED** reported again to City of Doncaster Council (CDC) and added to the agenda for the Liaison meeting to escalate.
- c) **26/07/2026** Email from MP with response from Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs in response to tackling non-compliant water company sewage spills and monitoring discharges to the environment. **RESOLVED** circulated to members
- d) **28/07/2026** Email received from a resident asking why double yellow lines had not been installed on Alderson Drive. The resident advised that access is frequently obstructed during cricket club matches and events due to inconsiderate parking of vehicles. **RESOLVED** the resident was advised that previous information received from CDC stated that road markings would not be installed in locations where Enforcement Officers are not routinely scheduled to carry out enforcement outside the town centre. The matter has been added to the agenda for the next CDC liaison meeting to raise the issue again.
- e) **28/07/2028** An email was received advising of two incidents that occurred during a bowling match. A member of the visiting team was struck on the head by a sun parasol that was blown over by the wind, and a separate incident involved a bee/wasp sting. The incidents were reported in accordance with the Bowling Club's Health and Safety procedures. It was also reported that members of the public had moved the safety barriers and were sitting beneath the overhang to seek shade. **RESOLVED:** The Bowling Club was reminded that the safety barriers have been installed to protect members of the public while roof repairs remain outstanding. A date for the repairs is scheduled and in the meantime, under no circumstances should the barriers be moved or removed, nor should anyone be permitted to sit or stand within the restricted area until the repair works have been completed.
- f) **03/07/2026** Email from resident concerned that the hedgerows lining the footpath through the community orchard are becoming overgrown and obstructing the path.

RESOLVED information circulated to members and clerk to prepare a report on maintenance for consideration. Resident updated.

- g) **06/07/2026** telephone call from member of the public who previously got in touch to send the council a copy of a Yorkshire poem they had written and wanted to let members know it is now printed on a t-shirt should members wish to purchase it the Clerk has details. **RESOLVED** information circulated.
- h) **06/07/2026** Telephone call for a very concerned resident to report the potential theft of the family grave. Established it was in the cemetery opposite the Church which is maintained by CDC. **RESOLVED** resident put in touch with CDC bereavement Services and Ward Cllrs to follow it up.
- i) **07/07/2026** Email from young resident with an interest in gardening wishing to offer services for grass cutting in the cemetery. **RESOLVED** information on responsibility for cemeteries and who to contact provided, also information on volunteering opportunities in the community orchard.
- j) **08/07/2026** Resident complaint received regarding disruption from the alleged miss use of the bouncy castle at the Carpenters Arms. **RESOLVED** signposted to CDC, Ward Councillors and licensing authority if the issue is one of breach of licensing conditions
- k) **09/07/2026** Further communication regarding the overgrown hedges on Common Lane. Spoke to CDC to report again, as Tickhill Town Council have no authority to take action in this area other than to report and chase. Member of the team at CDC scheduled a visit to assess the safety and plan next steps. **RESOLVED** advised resident to contact CDC directly for an update and the item will be discussed at the CDC liaison meeting on 13/07/2026
- l) **13/07/2026** Invitation for the Chair/Mayor to attend the 80th Anniversary Exhibition to celebrate 80 years of the Doncaster Civic Trust. **RESOLVED** invitation forwarded to Chair and response to confirm attendance sent to secretary of Civic Trust.
- m) **13/07/2026** Email notification of proposal to install a zebra crossing on Sunderland Street. **RESOLVED** circulated to members
- n) **18/07/2026** Email via webform from concerned resident about potential breach of planning on Paper Mill Lane. **RESOLVED** responded to resident, email provided on webform invalid.
- o) **19/07/2026** Email via webfor requesting information on applying for a memorial plaque on benched around the Mill Dam. **RESOLVED** referred to CDC and sent link to relevant information page with contact form on Doncaster Council website.
